## **Victim in Shooting Being Treated at Harborview**

A man who was shot early Thursday morning in the 1000 block of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street was transported earlier today to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle for treatment.

A 25-year-old Yakima resident, whose name is being withheld pending notification of his family, reportedly received gunshots to his foot, groin, and torso. After initially being treated at a local hospital, he was taken by aircraft to Harborview.

Yakima police responded to a call of shots fired in the 1000 block of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street at about 3:30 am today (Thursday, April 4<sup>th</sup>). When officers arrived on scene, they found the victim in the backyard of a residence suffering from gunshot wounds.

Yakima police continue to investigate the incident. No arrests have been made at this time.
