Police Investigating A&A Mini Mart Armed Robbery

The Yakima Police Department (YPD) is investigating an armed robbery at a mini-mart located at 708 N. 5th Avenue that occurred at about 8:40 pm on Friday.

Witnesses reported that a man entered A&A Mini Mart at about 8:40 pm Friday, pointed what police believe is an assault-type rifle at the clerk and demanded money. The suspect fled the mini mart with an undisclosed amount of cash.

A YPD K-9 search was launched, but the suspect was not located. Police learned that the suspect had gotten in a vehicle located a short distance from the mini mart and left the immediate area.

Yakima police continue to investigate the incident.
