Property and Evidence Unit hours are Tuesday through Thursday from 9:00 A.M. to 1:0 P.M. The property room is closed Mondays and Fridays.

If you are unable to recover your proeprty at the listed times or within sixty (60) days, contact the Property and Evidence Unit at (509) 575-622. If you wish to have another perosn recover your proeprty for you, a statement signed by you and Corrections Staff, will be required. Also, notarized letters authorizing release will be accepted. **Picture ID is required for all persons picking up property.** 

If we are not contacted wihtin sixty (60) days form the above date, the property will be disposed of as provided by law. No further notice will be sent.
